DRESSING ROOM QUOTES

American Conference

O. J. Simpson: (on player of game award) "This was unreal today. It's a tremendous honor just to be selected. This was what I call a fun game and I haven't had many in pro football. Mercury Morris and myself were kidding each other all week about who was going to win the award. After looking at our guards, one of us had to win it. One time I was pulling out and was going to cut off Gene Upshaw's block but he just ran over his man. ~~XXXX~~ Man, I've never seen blocking like this."

Roy Gerela: "I don't know what happened ~~orxx~~ who hit me on the tackle (referring to tackle of Ron Smith on 55-yard kickoff return). I'm just supposed to kick, ~~xxmx~~ not tackle."

Coach Chuck Noll (on seeing Gerela hurt): "I was hoping we wouldn't have to use him again as a tackler." (on game in general) "We felt like we had to run the ball. A lot of coaches feel in this kind of game that the passing ~~x~~ attack is the main feature but we thought we had the backs to open up the game at any time."

John Hadl: "It was a lot of fun to play against the best. I felt good throwing the ball and had excellent protection."

~~x~~ Larry Little: "We had a real good game. It's been a tremendous season for me personally and it's nice to finish like this. We traded licks with some great players today and the experience was tremendous."

National ~~Sanfranciscan~~ Conference

Coach Tom Landry: "Errors made the difference. They did more with theirs. We got the breaks in the first half." (on Simpson) "He's a great back and a great runner. He did most of it on individual ability. This is an individual ability type of game."

John Brockington: "This was a fun game. Nobody got hurt and that's the big thing. I had the breaks. . . I made a lucky catch and the line was blowing them off." O.J. had a great game. . . they ought to look at that all-pro selection."

Tommy Nobis: "This game could be 'something else' with the kind of talent they have assembled for it. O.J. made us look ~~xxm~~ kinda of funny at times."

Dick Butkus: "We would like to have won but we got some bad breaks. That's not new from where I am from."

Billy Kilmer: "It's an honor for me to have played in the game. I had never played in it before and I think it's great. The coaches did a great job of getting us ~~xxx~~ ready." (in reply to question about Landry calling plays) "No, he was very good about that but he could have done anything he wanted to. He's an extremely intelligent man and coach. Now I know why he's a winner."

MORE ON AFC TO COME

Bobby Bell on his interception for the touchdown: "I had dropped straight back and could see he (Snead) was in trouble. When he looked out in ~~the~~ the flat I knew he was going to dump it. I just rolled into the area where Garrison was open and he threw it up for grabs. Both teams wanted to win the game; they were trying to salvage something after the Super Bowl but we wanted a clean sweep.

Ted Hendricks: "I was ~~w~~ worried for a while especially ~~xxx~~ early in the game. We made a lot of mistakes and ~~any~~ they were capitalizing on them. I thought it might turn into a rout, but we hung together, eliminated our mistakes and ~~xxx~~ forced them into the turnovers. (ON HIS INTERCEPTION: "The ball seemed to hang in the air a little, and I just reached up and grabbed it. I should have had the other one earlier."

Otis Taylor: On his touchdown: I just ran an outside pattern then hooked back ~~ink~~ between the safeties. Daryle (Lamonica) had told me all week to look for that. He would look to onside, then comback to me."

On the AFC-NFC rivalry: "There's no doubt about it...it~~xx~~ still exists. It may not be as intense as the old days, but ~~ixix~~ it's there. We (the AFC team) wanted to win when we started workouts Monday. Coach Noll told us the first day we were here to win and that was the attitude of the entire team all week.
