Overview

The NFL GSIS Data Interface application is a program which allows users to view the information from a specific game, either live or historical, in real time via the receipt of files generated from GSIS Stat Entry. It also allows them to store selected .xml files to a local path on their computer or to a MSMQ or FTP endpoint.

Requirements

- Windows PC
- v6.0.0 Installer folder/files
- Microsoft .NET Framework 4.8 or higher (included in v6.0.0 installer folder; will automatically install if needed)
- Internet connection

Installation

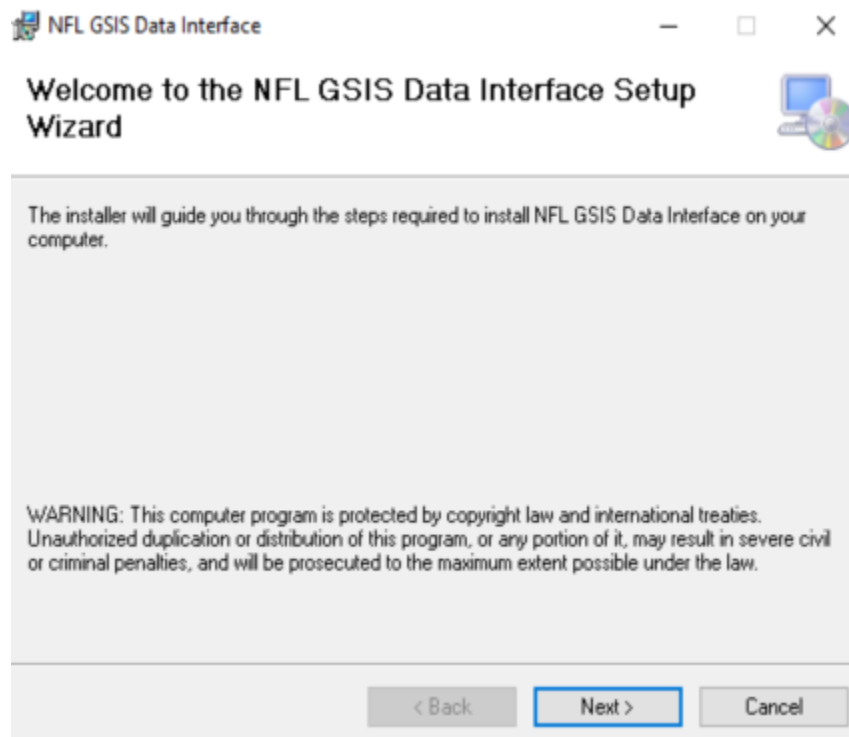
1. If it was not already supplied to you, download the NFL GSIS Data Interface v6.0.0 (available via <https://www.nflgsis.com/gsisupdate/>) by clicking the 'Download' button.



2. Unzip the downloaded file, then open the folder that was created. If you currently have an older version of the NFL GSIS Data Interface installed (ex: 3.0.0, 5.0.0, 5.0.1), or if you are unsure whether or not you have an older version installed, go to step 3. Otherwise, proceed to step 4.
3. Shift+right click on the 'Uninstall.cmd' file, and select 'Run as administrator'. This will open a Command Prompt window and begin the automated uninstall process. When you see 'Uninstall successful' text in the prompt window, you can press any key to close the uninstaller.

4. Shift+right click on the 'Setup.cmd' file, and select 'Run as administrator'. This will open the NFL GSIS Data Interface Setup Wizard.

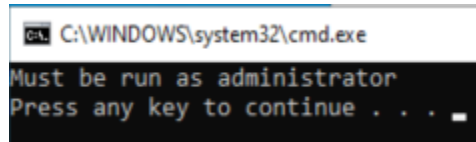


- a. To begin the installation, select 'Next' to reach the 'Select Installation Folder' screen
 - b. You may select 'Next' if you wish for the NFL GSIS Data Interface to be installed with the default Folder location and User(s) to reach the 'Confirm Installation' screen. Otherwise, you can change these options before selecting 'Next'.
 - c. Select 'Next'. The installation will now automatically proceed and, when completed, display the 'Installation Complete' screen.
 - d. Select 'Close' to exit the 'Installation Complete' screen.
5. Installation is now completed and you will see a 'GSIS Data Interface' icon on your desktop which you can use to access the NFL GSIS Data Interface v6.0.0 application. **NOTE:** If you had an active registration with a previous version of the NFL GSIS Data Interface, that registration will still be active when you login to NFL GSIS Data Interface v6.0.0. Also, all selections and entries in the 'View>Settings' menu (ex: Local Save Path, MSMQ Endpoints, etc.) from a previous version of NFL GSIS Data Interface on your computer will be retained after logging into to NFL GSIS Data Interface v6.0.0.



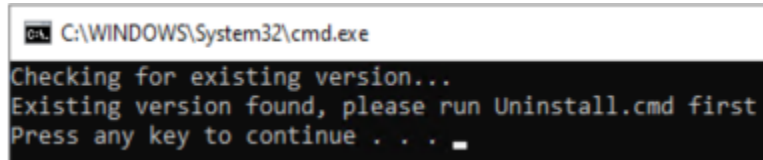
Troubleshooting

- **Issue:** When selecting 'Setup.cmd' and/or 'Uninstall.cmd', a Command Prompt window that says 'Must be run as administrator' appears.



Solutions:

- o Ensure the Windows user you are accessing your computer with has Administrator privileges, otherwise the Data Interface cannot be installed.
 - o Make sure you are right-clicking on the file and selecting 'Run as administrator', not just double clicking the file.
- **Issue:** When selecting 'Setup.cmd', a Command Prompt window that says 'Existing version found, please run Uninstall.cmd first' appears.



Solution: Run the 'Uninstall.cmd' file as an Administrator, then once the uninstall process has completed, run 'Setup.cmd' again.
